

STUDENT TRAVEL AWARD INFORMATION

Spring 2019

The UNLV Foundation is honored to have a wonderful partnership with Southwest Airlines. Through Southwest Airlines' generous support, current students are eligible to apply for one round trip anywhere Southwest flies within the U.S. for academic or professional purposes. A committee will select up to seven Southwest Travel Awardees for Spring 2019.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be currently enrolled as a student at UNLV.
2. Travel award must be used for academic or professional advancement purposes related to student's current degree program.
3. All travel must be completed by July 1, 2019.
4. Recipients of the travel award must provide a post-trip report to the UNLV Foundation. This report of at least 250 words will describe their experience and explain how it will serve to progress their academic goals. It is encouraged that reports include photos.

How to Apply:

1. Submit the online Student Travel Award Application (<https://goo.gl/forms/T7So8KqDJM7OdUI72>) no later than **5:00pm, Thursday, January 31, 2019**.
2. Have one UNLV faculty or staff member submit an online Recommendation Form (<https://goo.gl/forms/MmfXjX30REV9vthg1>) on your behalf no later than **5:00pm, Thursday, January 31, 2019**.

FAQs:

When will I find out if I have been awarded the travel voucher?

Award winners will be notified by February 28, 2019.

Can I purchase my flight in advance and be reimbursed if I am chosen as the awardee?

No. No funds, only travel passes for flights on Southwest Airlines, are awarded.

If my plans change, can I use the travel award for a different travel purpose?

No. Travel awards may only be used for the travel purpose stated in the award application.

Where can I travel using the award?

Round trip travel passes are redeemable for Southwest flights within the 48 contiguous states.

Which students are eligible to apply for the award?

All currently enrolled UNLV students (full time, part time, undergraduate, graduate, etc.) are welcome to apply.

Can I have more than one recommendation form submitted on my behalf?

No, only one recommendation per student will be reviewed by the committee. If more than one recommendation is received, only the first recommendation will be considered.

Please note that the information included in your application will be reviewed by members of the selection committee. No information will be shared with Southwest Airlines.
